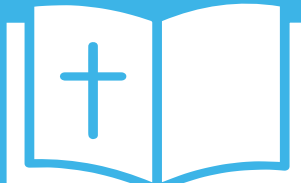

Together with our partners we were able to provide over 7000 thousand meals for displaced people, refugees, and for struggling with poverty and crisis. From family food bags hand delivered to homes, to prepared nutritious hot meals lovingly served, your efforts enabled us to keep many individuals and families from going hungry.

We have been able to provide firewood or electric heaters to families in several smaller communities in Ukraine. We have also provided enough firewood to keep a warming center in Boryspil, Ukraine operational 24 hours a day all winter. Hundreds of vulnerable people will be safe and warm this winter.



## Feeding and Bringing Hope to Refugees

In Kremenets, Ukraine, Pastor Alexey and Valentina from Water of Life Church have been distributing weekly aid at "The Social Hub", often small food packets, to displaced families and the disabled in town.

Most of the new residents are struggling to survive in their new "home." Many are still living in temporary housing where there are limited amenities. *People survive because of the food they receive at the Hub. The emotional and spiritual impact on their lives is immeasurable!*

"After we gave out food at the Hub, a young mother came to talk to me. We have been building a relationship with her for several months. She asked if it was ok to come to church the next day. We talked about Jesus and prayed. She wanted to know more." *Valentina*



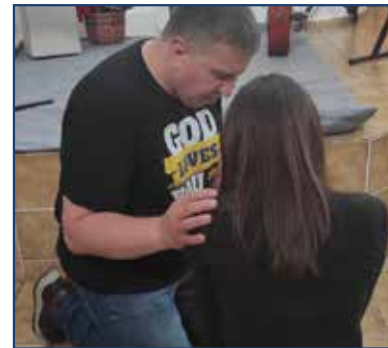




In 2024, your support enabled over 1200 children and youth to attend weekly Bible clubs, conferences, camps, or holiday celebrations from 25 different communities around Ukraine, Poland, and Belarus!

These outreach programs were combined with ongoing Christian mentorship for families. Throughout 2024 many relationships were built as local partners served vulnerable people in their communities and children and families received hope.

Mission Partners was also able to make several small renovation investments into church meeting spaces. These buildings continue to be spaces for both humanitarian and spiritual outreach.



## Teaching Kids about Jesus at Christmas Events

We held a two day Christmas camp for children in Szczecin, Poland. Many were Ukrainian refugee children. Twelve of the children had never attended church before. There were crafts, games, dances, and the ministry team prayed together with the families.

**We showed a Christmas movie where the main character learned the real meaning of Christmas. We explained to the children that Jesus is the only way to Heaven.**

"During the movie, children were amazed and emotionally moved. In the story a boy, was unfairly accused of doing something wrong. The children burst into tears. **After the event a young boy said that he wanted to be good and overcome evil.** Another boy has now started attending church regularly. He gets excited waiting for Sunday School lessons." *Pastor Vitaly*





One of the key pillars of our mission is our partnership with our local “boots-on-the-ground” community partners. Our goal is to work through these faithful men and women to share hope and bring healing to the broken lives they encounter in their communities, but also to support them and their families directly.

Through MPI programs like SOUL Care and other emergency help, over 30 leaders have been supported, visited by MPI staff, regularly encouraged, and their urgent needs met.

In 2024, 60% of total expenditures went to our charitable programs, 26% was spent on administration, and 14% was spent on fundraising/promotion.

**We are grateful to God** that despite facing many challenges on the mission field, God has allowed us to continue to do impactful ministry in Ukraine and Belarus, and has strengthened new partnerships in Poland. We are grateful for each and every life rescued and for every heart that received hope through our collective efforts.

**Thanks to God's provision, and to your contributions, we were able to fulfil our ministry obligations throughout our partnership network in 2024.** Through the daily sacrificial outreach efforts of our local ministry partners, many hundreds of people received help accompanied by the message of hope in Christ. The work continues! Though we celebrate each person that we have impacted, we know that many more still need to hear the message that Jesus loves and cares for them. Every year, we have a waiting list of people who still need the help that we want to offer.
